We will be staying in the beautiful 18th Century manor house with full catering facilities. Each dormitory (typically for 4 – 6 boys) has ensuite toilet and showers. We will be making good use of the centre's 25 acres of forest and open areas as well as an AstroTurf sports pitch, basketball court and indoor sports hall. Activities will be many and varied including: sports, forest games, expeditions, outdoor survival skills and activity workshops.

WHO?

There will be two camps running alongside each other; one for boys in school Years 5 and 6, the other for boys in school Years 7 and 8. The two camps will be run jointly by Kelston, Westpark and Greygarth clubs along with staff at the Lea Green centre. The camp has full insurance cover against accidents or injuries.

We will depart on the morning of Monday 27th May and return on the evening of Friday 31st May. Transport will be organised from the respective clubs; further details will be sent to parents closer to the camp date.
